# Course Philosophy

This class uses a variety of instructional methods (e.g., lectures, discussions, and demonstrations and instructional strategies (e.g., cooperative learning, and project and problem-based learning) to deliver the course content. In **cooperative learning**, you will work together in groups or teams to seek a solution to an identified problem. In a cooperative learning situation, all members have an assigned duty related to completing the task or solving the problem. In a **project-based learning** activity, you will work cooperatively over time to create a product, presentation, or performance. In **problem-based learning**, you will work cooperatively to investigate and resolve an ill-structured problem based on real-world issues or situations. Everything we do in this class will model what you will do one day in your own class. It is expected that students in this class will be reflective and cognizant of the variety of teaching methods and their application in TEE classrooms.
